## WORSHIP

### Traditional Service (8:30 & 11:00 a.m.)

The first Sunday in November is celebrated as "All Saints Sunday" by many churches. It is an opportunity to emphasize and interpret the doctrine of "The Communion of the Saints" which we affirm in the Apostle's Creed. The word "Saint" here does not mean a revered person who performed meritorious works and intercedes in our behalf before God.

Rather it is the New Testament sense of the word "saint," which means any member of the Christian community. (ie: Philippians 1:1, Colossians 1:2, Ephesians 1:1, etc.) The usage comes from many of the New Testament letters where the writers refer to the all of the "saints" in the community who will be reading the letter. In the doctrine of the Communion of the Saints, the church has affirmed the biblical truth that our life together in the Christian community includes not only the living Christians around us, but those Christians in other places on earth, and those Christians who have died and now reside in God's care, love, and fulfillment. Across time and space we find fellowship (or communion) with them through Jesus Christ.

### Connection Service (8:30 & 9:45 a.m.)

Today in our Connection Services we are continuing our study of Spiritual Gifts in our series entitled "12X12". The Body of Jesus, the church, was drawn together to work in community. As we look into Paul's words describing this he holds up a variety of gifts and we'll look at them, thinking about their role and place in our lives. As we get called to serve God in the world, the gifts of the Holy Spirit teach us that we will be equipped with the wherewithal to get the job done.

### Vespers (6:00 p.m. in the Chapel)

The service, which utilizes scripture readings, contemplation, and prayer, is a quiet service that lasts about a half hour, and includes the Sacrament of Communion.

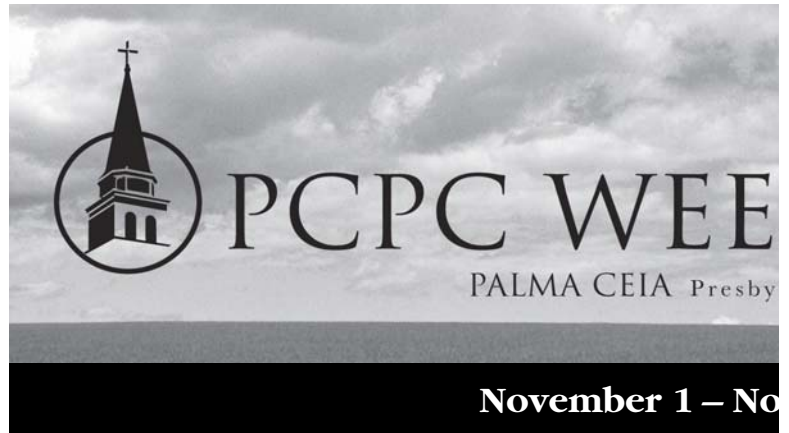

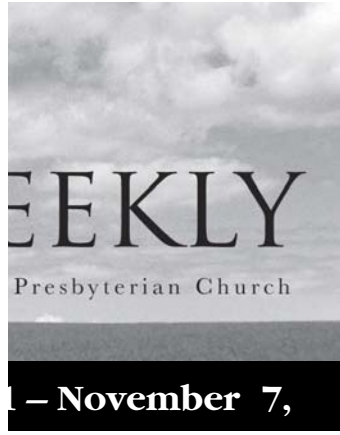
